Housing Sales Now At GFC Levels In June 2024 - REINZ Describes The Market As 'A Little Chilly'

The housing market in New Zealand experienced a significant decline in June, reminiscent of the Global Financial Crisis (GFC) era.

The Real Estate Institute of NZ (REINZ) reported 4,356 residential sales in June, down 25.6% from June last year and 33.3% from May this year.

This marks the lowest June sales since 2008, excluding June 2020 during the pandemic restrictions.

The sales slump was widespread, with Auckland seeing a 35.1% drop from last year, and the rest of the country (excluding Auckland) down 20.7%.

Northland was the only region with an increase in sales, up 11.9% compared to June last year.

The West Coast, Tasman, Gisborne, and Auckland had the most significant annual declines in sales.

June's sales figures were lower than in May across all regions. Despite the decline in sales, new listings and total stock on the market increased.

REINZ reported 7,805 new listings in June, up 25.5% from last year, creating a significant overhang of unsold properties.

Total residential stock for sale at the end of June was 31,745, up 28.6% from last year.

Prices showed slight resilience, with the REINZ House Price Index falling 0.7% nationally in June and 2.3% in the second quarter.

Rodney District in northern Auckland saw the largest monthly decline at 3.5%, while Lower Hutt and Wellington City had the most significant quarterly drops at 3.9%.

The REINZ described the market as "a little chilly" due to economic challenges, with increased listings
